- Purpose To ensure appropriate use of the Library internet workstations by Library patrons.
- Definitions Library means the Beaverlodge Public Library

Policy 1. Unacceptable Use of Internet Workstations

- 1.1 The Library prohibits the use of its internet workstations for illegal purposes. Such illegal and unacceptable activities include, but are not limited to:
 - a. The harassment, libeling or slander of others, the display, viewing, or dissemination of hate literature, pornography, illicit drug literature or obscene material
 - b. The display, viewing or dissemination of material depriving any person of their rights, exposing any person to hatred, affronting human dignity, or invading the privacy of others
 - c. Carrying out fraud whether through personal misrepresentation or any other means
- 1.2 When faced with unacceptable behaviour at the Internet stations, staff will issue a verbal warning to the patron to terminate the session. If the behaviour persists or is illegal, staff will notify the RCMP immediately.
